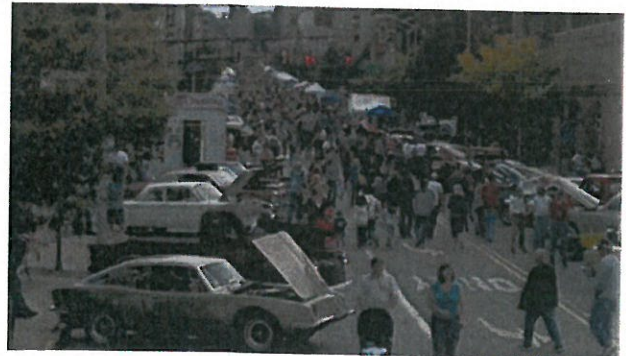

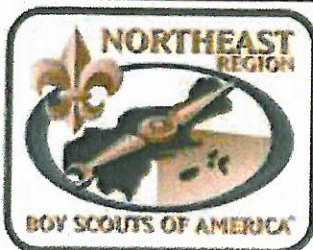
Funds will also go towards insurance vehicle maintenance, fuel, registration and updated safety equipment.

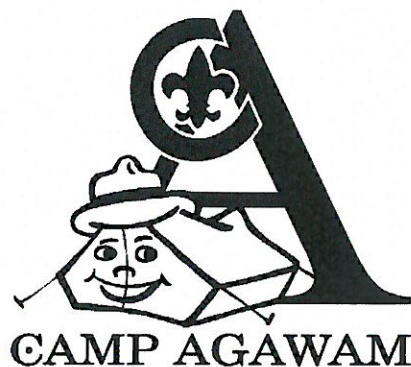

"HIKE 100 CHALLENGE"

April 22nd-24th

In 2016, the National Park Service is celebrating their centennial anniversary, and everyone can take part in the 100 miles for 100 years celebration! The centennial will kick off a second century of stewardship of America's national parks and engaging communities through recreation, conservation, and historic preservation programs.



Anyone who hikes 100 miles on the North Country Trail during the calendar year of 2016, in aggregate or all at once, will be eligible for a special patch and certificate.

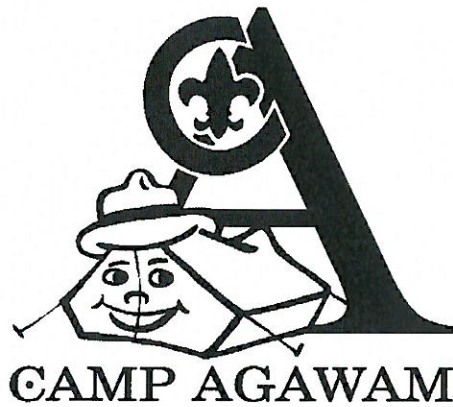

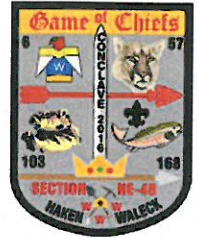
